Take Stock in Children of Broward is the local affiliate of a statewide non-profit organization that is transforming Florida one student at a time. Working in every county throughout Florida, our mission is to break the cycle of poverty for low-income, academically qualified students by providing opportunities for a post-secondary education. We offer college scholarships to students, provide caring volunteer mentors, and instill hope for a better life. Our comprehensive services begin in middle school, continue through high school, and include students' transition into college and career. Once selected to enroll in our program and receive a Florida Prepaid scholarship, each student signs a contract promising to adhere to TSIC guidelines (i.e., maintain good grades, attendance, and behavior, while leading a crimefree and drug-free lifestyle).

Since 1995, Take Stock in Children (TSIC) statewide has provided 34,348 children with scholarships and mentors. Over 97% of TSIC scholars graduate high school and 92% go on to pursue a post-secondary education, with a 68% college graduation rate, well over the national average. Locally TSIC has served 1,500 of these students and awarded nearly \$15 million in scholarships!

The TSIC program has become a role model organization receiving state and national recognition for its exemplary successes. TSIC was recognized by the State of Florida as a flagship mentoring program as demonstrated in a study performed by OPPAGA (Office of Program Policy Analysis & Government Accountability). We are also a recognized educational innovator -- In 2010, TSIC Broward was one of three local TSIC programs to be the recipient of a U.S. Department of Education Investing in Innovation (I3) grant, a program that recognizes the most promising educational models with the potential to be adopted nationally.

Other recognitions include: 2015 Non-Profit Organization of the Year in Innovation- Broward 211 Non-Profit Awards, 2016 Non-Profit Organization of the Year Community Choice- Broward 211 Non-Profit Awards, and 2017 Non-Profit Small Business of the Year- Fort Lauderdale Chamber of Commerce.





